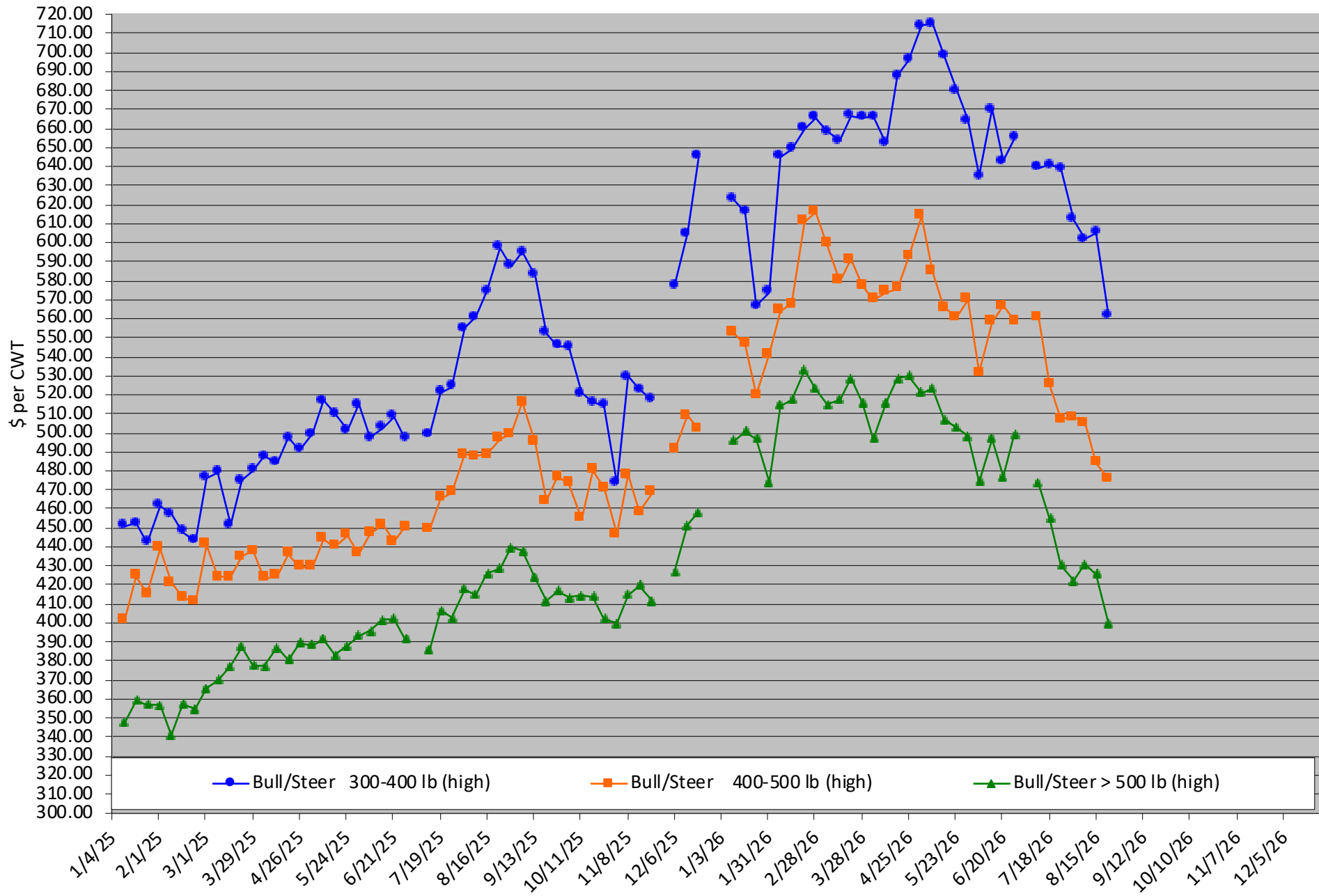

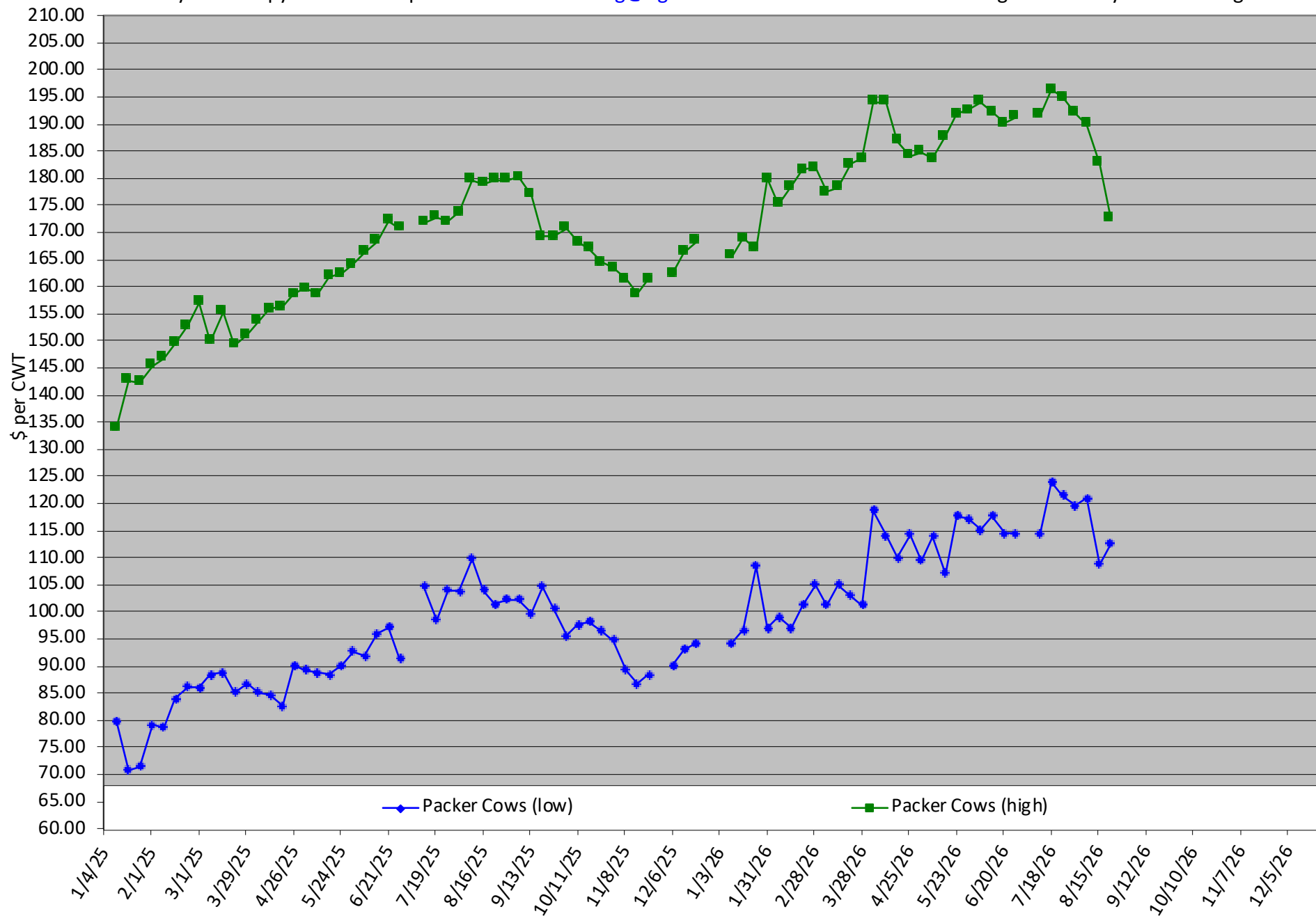


Packer Cow PriceTrends

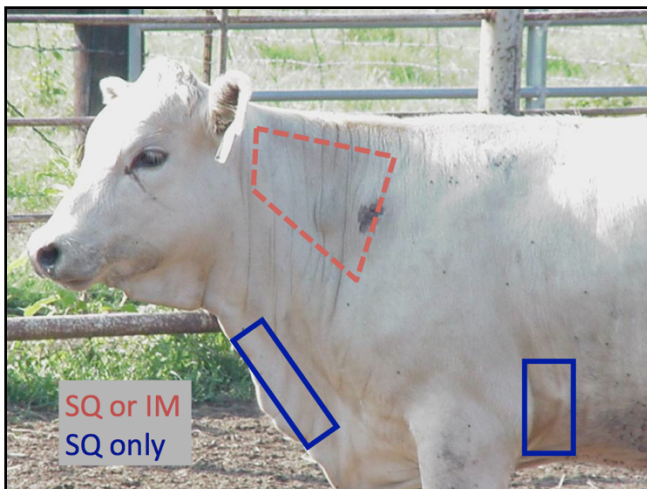
